## Defense in Ellis Glenn Trial Begin the Presentation of Their Side of Case.

Parkersburg, July 18—The state rested its side of the Ellis Glenn case at noon today, but reserved the right to recall any witness it might deem necessary. All the witnesses for the state stated that Ellis or Bert Glenn had a scar on the head and hand. The defense put two witnesses on the stand this afternoon both of whom testified they had made a personal examination of Ellis Glenn's head and hand and that there was no scar in either place and no evidence that there have been any. This was one of the state's strongest points in the identification of the prisoner and the defense found conclusively that the prisoner was free from the scars mentioned.
