Dear Lou,

Thanks for your last letter and congratulations on your operation. Also thanks for the information about penile surgery. A friend of mine in B.C. had this particular operation done (like the one you described to me) by a team in (headed by Dr. Clark B. Papay) Portland, Oregon a few years ago but he too is hoping for something better / faster in the future. The two most promising operations I can see (if not at the immediate present, at least, in about 5 years or so) are the respective ones by: Dr. Edgerton in Charlottesville Virginia at the U. of Virginia gender clinic (cost: approx. \$4,000 - \$6,000) * 3 stage operation there, and also, the one by: Dr. Charles Reynolds, Jr. in Oklahoma City at the Urology Center there (cost: \$6,000 - \$12,000 approx.) ->

- with a ^{sensitive} glans/ head (^{erotic} sensitive) + re-routed urethral canal through the phallic tube + semi-erectile powers. Dr. Reynolds did this operation at Stanford University in front of medical doctors and students in 1979 and also wrote & delivered a paper on it (I don't know if it's published yet nor in what ^{medical} journal) - perhaps Jude Patton would know. I hope to undergo this surgery (by Dr. Reynolds) sometime in the indefinite future (once I've ^{medically} saved up the necessary money, and it's ^{medically} enough for me). Meanwhile I'm still awaiting Dr. Paul Walker's company's penile prosthesis - do you have any recent info' on this from Paul?
