A girl's dilemma

A 21-YEAR-OLD girl who appeared in court in men's clothes and was said to regard herself as a boy baffled the hospital to which she was sent for treatment.

Christine Vensettie, of Bryanston-street, Marylebone, London, was said to have refused to wear women's clothing, and to have made passes at other girls.

An after-care officer said at Clerkenwell, London, that the hospital to which Vensettie was sent was unable to help her and would not accept her for treatment.

On a charge of stealing a bicycle she was sent to prison for a month so she could be kept under medical observation.
