






ne of the topgrossing (over 100 million and counting) films this year is.......

(drumroll)...a mainstream, highly entertaining, political satire, The Birdcage. It's about a star TG (notice the capital "T"), Nathan Lane, as Albert/Starina, the boa-clad, drag headliner/heroine. Along with Robin (Mrs. Doubtfire) Williams, they portray an overboard (but never bored), happy, loving, humorous, wholesome, long-lasting gay couple. TGs have once again

advanced their status and cause as this *Birdcage* couple are viewed as likable and sympathetic, and especially as acceptable.

Birds of a Feather was, understandably, the original working title of the film. Set in South Miami Beach, the plot (is there anyone out there who doesn't know by now) centers around two, mature gay men — one of whom has a 21-year old son from a prior marriage, who is "...going to the chapel and

gonna get married..." to an "actual" girl! The other partner is an out-going, sensitive, somewhat campy and dramatic, drag queen.

In order to present the image of a normal man-woman couple for their son's pending and very conservative in-laws (Gene Hackman and Diane Wiest), Albert/Starina pretends to be his partner's wife, "Mrs. Coleman." The farce that follows is dee-lite-full. Posilutely everything works out wonderfully a la Joe E. Brown and Jack Lemon in Some Like It Hot. And, yes, Albert and Armand actually do kiss. It is that R-E-A-L.

1978 French film, La Cage Aux Folles, which proved an enormous hit in its native country, around the world and in the U.S. La Cage was so successful it even had a sequel. Later still (1984), for its third incarnation, it was transformed into a fabulous Broadway Tony Awardwinning musical. The fact that audiences were ripe for a remake is a tribute to the growing acceptance of TGs all over the world. Also, the current generation of movie-goers are more

open, more educated, less bigoted. They've also seen, and many have learned to love, Ru Paul, Dennis Rodman, and other TG celebrities.

The main point and the bottom line is that audiences will shell out multi-millions of dollars to see quality films about positive TG characters (Birdcage, To Wong Foo, Priscilla), stories (Stonewall, Ed Wood) and events (Wigstock). The silver lining to this beautiful mosaic is that typically the following formula prevails: awareness + understanding = tolerance.

Politically speaking, and TG issues, as Riki Anne Wilchins says, are frequently political, *Birdcage* is *prima*

facie evidence for the case of same-gender marriages. It is equally proof positive that any relationship with a TG person. CD. TS. DQ, DK or whatever, can succeeed if it is treated honestly, respectfully and lovingly by both parties, whether the partners are of the same or the opposite sex works.

If Birdcage has any deeper meaning, perhaps it is that the time has come to clean out the cage and give the bird (British for girl) some fresh water and a fresh breath of air. Does this mean come out and be proud? Of course, it does! So, if you haven't seen Birdcage, check it out on video, or better yet, get

gussied up and see it in a theater. Either way, realize and appreciate the very symbolic general public acceptance of the transgender phenomenon (and YOU) this film represents.
