Vocabulary

Assigned sex — sex recorded at birth, usually on the basis of external genitalia. Coming out — revealing gender difference, opposite of attempting to pass. Crossdresser (CD) — man or woman who dresses in clothes of the other sex some of the time. Drag king — woman, usually lesbian, who dresses as a man. Drag queen — gay man who dresses as a woman for fun. Drag — putting on the appearance of something you are not, especially a different sex. Dressing — crossdressing. Female impersonator (FI) — man who dresses as a woman to entertain others. Female-to-male (FTM); transsexual man — transsexual who was assigned female sex at birth. Gender community — network of support groups, events, organizations, and contacts for transgendered people. Gender expression — behavior through which association with a gender is communicated. Gender — self-identification as man, woman, or other. Genderphobia — hatred or fear of deviation from gender norms. Genetic girl (GG) — nontranssexual woman. Genetic — nontranssexual. Intersex — conditions in which genitalia are not clearly male or female. Living — living as a member of the other sex, cross-living. Male-to-female (MTF); transsexual woman - transsexual who was assigned male sex at birth. Non — nontranssexual. Passing man — man who passes as a woman, identifies as a man. Passing woman — woman who passes as a man, identifies as a woman. Passing — not being perceived as differently gendered. Reading — perceiving a person as transgendered. Real-life test (RLT) — required period of cross-living before SRS. Sex reassignment surgery (SRS) — surgery that changes external genitalia from one sex to those resembling the other sex. Sex — categorization as male, female, or other by the shape of genitalia or other biological features. Sexual orientation — categorization based on the sex or gender of the persons one is erotically attracted to. Transgender or transgendered — often used to mean differently gendered in any way; transperson or transpeople is better. Transgenderist (TG) — person who identifies and lives as a member of the other sex without surgery. Transperson/transpeople — inclusive term for differently sexed and differently gendered individuals. Transphobia — hatred or fear of transsexuals. Transsexual (TS or just T) — person whose gender identity is different from biological sex, usually seeks SRS and hormone therapy. Transvestite (TV) — heterosexual man who sometimes enjoys dressing in women's clothing, often for erotic stimulation.
