American hospitals cut into 5 intersexed children <u>every</u> day, just to make their genitals look "normal." Most will lose genital sensation. <u>Many are cut at GWU Medical</u>

Did you know...

According to the American Academy of Pediatricians' statement on Intersex Genital Mutilation, intersex children are genitally cut to minimize "<u>emotional, cognitive, and body image</u>" problems, and <u>not for medical</u> <u>reasons</u>. Intersex children need counseling, <u>not</u> cutting.

GWU Prof Barry Belman says that non-complaining intersex children *as young as 2 weeks to 2-3 years of age must be genitally cut.* Has he ever heard of "*informed consent*?"
