

HOT PEACHES is one of New York's most original musical comedy troupes. Since their founding in 1972, they have consistently delighted and challenged audiences with their often-outrageous blend of social, political and sexual satire. Their theatrical style presents performance in a circus-like atmosphere of high-camp parody, lavish costumes and make-up, and rock & roll music. This is their first visit to Britain since 1977.

Written by founder member JIMMY CAMICIA, THE HEAT is a retrospective cabaret telling the history of HOT PEACHES from its founding in 1972 to the present day. The show features excerpts from the 'best of' HOT PEACHES' mod-cap humour with music by JIMMY CAMICIA, JOE LONGO and JAN [REDACTED]. It is threaded together by a funny, poignant travelogue beginning in New York in 1972, travelling through London, Amsterdam, Berlin and Italy and winding up in present-day Greenwich Village. The cabaret played to sold-out houses in both New York and Europe in 1990 and this is its British premiere.
