

TED CLAUS, also known as Clause tchu Nez, formerly of Fort Defiance and Navajo has just completed a commission for a mural at the Museum of Navajo Ceremonial Art in Santa Fe, New Mexico. The mural depicts the masked dance of the ninth night of the Yehbechai Ceremony. The mural is 5° x 8° and is in the room which contains most of the holy objects used by Hosteen Klah, well known Navajo singer, who started the Museum as a shrine of the religious beliefs of the Navajo people.
