

UNKNOWN DEAD MAN IN WOMAN'S CLOTHES

Denver, Colo., June 10.—What is the strange story that lies hidden behind the dead face of a man found dead in a Larimer street rooming house yesterday morning fully dressed?

When the unknown was stripped by Coroner Rollins after the body was taken to the morgue, the man was found to have a woman's complete outfit of undergarments beneath his ragged man's suit.

Therefore the police are asking—What was the story? and was it humorous, pathetic or merely ordinary?

The man left no papers or cards to give the slightest clue to his identity. There was no mark on either his or the woman's clothes, both well-worn. The woman's garments were once of fine fabric and evidently very costly. Silk stockings and lace trimmed garments were on him although rather worn. Were they given him by some woman who took pity upon his destitute circumstances, or were they merely stolen from a clothes line while a wealthy woman of fashion was waiting for the return of her laundry? Whatever the manner in which he got the clothes the dead man at the coroner's tells no tales and the mystery will die as he died—unexplained. The death occurred in the rooming house at 1306 Larimer street. The man called there night before last and had just enough money to buy a cheap bed. He seemed ill, and the death is believed to be due to exposure and exhaustion. The man was middle aged.
