#### HERMAPHRODITISM

There are many questions asked of and about me and my brother, and our condition, therefore I shall in a general way attempt to answer them herein. However, I shall first touch upon the double sex problem.

HERMAPHRODITISM, as it is called, is defined in the Standard Dictionary as "That which has the sexual characteristics of both male and female in the same body."

Some writers claim that ADAM was the first HERMA-PHRODITE, and support this by Scriptural evidence.

In some of the ancient poets we find traces of an Egyptian Legend in which the goddess of the Moon was both male and female.

According to Mythology, Hermaphroditus was the son of Hermes and Aphrodite, and that he had the powers of both father and mother.

Ovid and Virgil both refer to legendary hermaphrodites, and the knowledge of their existence was prevalent in older times.

#### A FEW CASES

Reputable physicians in later years have reported cases where the person involved believed him or herself to be a man or a woman, until middle life, when the opposite sex asserted itself within that same body.

Catherine or Charles Hoffman, born in Germany, 1824, was considered a female until the age of 46. She married a woman and lived happily with her for some years.

Marie Madeline LeFort of France believed herself to be a woman for many years, and in 1864 came to the Hotel Dieu asking treatment for Pleurisy. At that time she or he was about 65 years of age, but presented the appearance of a venerable old man with a long white beard. After two months this patient died. An autopsy was held and the essentials of both sexes were then discovered in that same body.

Adelaide Preville was married as a female and lived as such. The last ten years of her life were spent in France. When dead, the body was dissected and it was discovered to be that of a man. Apparently the law of evolution in hermaphroditism prevents perfection.

Many interesting questions arise and extraordinary complications occur thus leaving much yet to be discussed legally and socially as to this condition we call Hermaphroditism.

Mother nature knows no rights, she knows no wrong. Yet furnishes enough marvels to set one thinking. The marvelous is the unusual, yet that which is unusual is not necessarily miraculous. The real wonder is that the people exist at all, and in the face of mother nature's great performance of miracles, ordinary freakdom pales into insignificance.

#### AS TO MYSELF

I was born in France, November 4, 1899. At birth I was given the name of Alberta. I was brought up as a girl and mingled with girls at school and at play with no idea as to what was taking place within my body.

At the age of ten years and eight months or thereabouts, the left side of my body was growing out of proportion to the right side. My mother became alarmed and called in the family physician. A thorough examination disclosed that I was developing the characteristics and form of a female in and on the left side of my body, while the right side was developing the characteristics and form of a male.

If you observe closely my photographs you will note the following characteristics:

There is no hair or muscle visible on the left side of the body. You will note the form and figure of a woman wearing a size  $4\frac{1}{2}$  shoe on the left foot. The right ankle tapers and the limb forms to accentuate the left hip like that of any well developed female. The features on the left side of the face are soft and moulded like that of a woman. From the left shoulder to the left hip the form is entirely feminine, making the entire left side of my body a perfect half woman.

On the right side of my body you will confront the form and physique of a man. The body on this side is rough, hairy and muscular like that of a well developed male. I wear size  $8\frac{1}{2}$  shoe on my right foot. The right ankle is large and the right lower limb is muscular, extending to the straight right hip which is developed like that of a man. The features on the right side of my face are hard and rough like that of a well matured male . . . My right arm is longer and stronger than my left arm.

#### WHAT AM I?

Some of the questions frequently asked me are: 'How do you dress on the street?" "Have you ever been in love?" "Whose company do you prefer and enjoy most, male or female?".

#### THE ANSWER

For 20 years of my life I have worn female attire. The past few years I have been wearing male attire because it is much easier to wear and makes me less conspicuous.

I was in love many times, yet I could never afford to let love affairs run away with me because I might not be what a young lady might expect; at the same time I would be a terrible disappointment to a young man. Therefore, I cannot marry.

I have many good friends of both sexes. I enjoy one as much as the other.

#### MY APPEARANCES IN PUBLIC

I came to this country at a fairly early age in the care of a noted medical man of France, and was at first exhibited in leading hospitals and medical schools throughout the civilized world.

I later exhibited in all the major theatrical circuits of United States and Canada, under the direction of Sam Wagner, famous Coney Island Showman.

#### HOW WE FEEL ABOUT IT

Sex pervades all nature. We might be one thing to the artist, another to the physician and still something else to the public. One man's faculties are not enough to penetrate this wholly fascinating mystery of nature.

We learn from our studies in Botany that the trees, flowers, and particularly clinging ivy and the blood red rose of lust are hemaphroditical and that they contain within the one calox, the organs of self generation.

#### DOUBLE BODIED HALF MAN

In response to many questions that are put to me daily by interested visitors, I am printing a few facts about myself that may be of interest to all.

HALF WOMAN

I was born in August, 1906, a short distance from Cracow. To be exact, I am Ukranian, and very proud of that fact. My people are middle class farmers working hard and, like most farmers, not making much money.

At the time of my birth I was given the name of Joseph and until the age of 12 was regarded as an ordinary boy, dressed and mixed with other boys. Just after reaching the age of 12, I understand I be-gan to act queerly and the family doctor, after many visits, decided that I possessed both sexes.

After I recovered I found myself in a very uncom-fortable position, for my former boy companions would have nothing to do with me as I was wearing girl's clothes. And neither would the girls for they looked upon me as a dressed-up boy. Everywhere I went people would point at me and whisper to each other. Finally this continued to such an extent that life became almost unendurable, and so I stayed in the house, very seldom going out. I became what you call in this country a "home girl," one of those domestic slaves who do everything for every-body that nobody else wants to do—and gets noth-ing for it. And so my life went on day after day and year after year. I used to get so depressed in spirits that I often thought of killing myself. I would have run away, but did not know where I could go. could go.

And then one day a young American came to us and made a proposition to take me to America and exhibit me. My father would not listen to it and neither would I, for I thought it meant being held up to ridicule. Finally he went away saying he would return in a year's time. Two months after that I began to receive a lot of illustrated newspapers and measures and then I received a heavily letter and magazines, and then I received a beautiful letter from his wife. I got my tutor to translate these and then I got papers and letters by nearly every mail.

And then one Sunday my American friend arrived again and this time with his wife. By this time I was just as eager to get to America as I was terrified on his first visit. They were very nice, but they said nothing about taking me back with them. A week went by and then 10 days passed and not a word word.

Yes and no. That word is now applied to all dou-ble sex births, but it is not correct to do so. An Hermophrodite should be 100 per cent. of both sexes, and should be self-producing. True Hermo-phroditism only exists amongst certain low forms of animal life animal life.

What is Josephine-Joseph's voice-male or female?

Josephine-Joseph has two voices. Generally through cultivation and use, speaks in the female voice. But the male voice always asserts itself under stress of emotion—such as anger, fear or pity.
