Their restored Victorian Ballroom is perfect for showing off your antique finery such as ostrich plume hat, whale-bone corset, high button shoes, and your great-grandma's bustle. This is the same room where we met in September 1990 and had a great evening.

Doors open at 8:00 p.m. with appetizer tray and cash bar beginning at 8:30. Dinner will be served at 9:30. *Everyone is expected to purchase a meal.*

Directions:

From Lancaster: PA-283 W to PA-230 W into Mount Joy. Turn right at Hamilton Bank on to N. Market St.

From Harrisburg: PA-283 E to PA-772 W into Mount Joy. Turn left at Hamilton Bank on to N. Market St.

From York: US-30 E to Columbia, exit onto PA-441 N, right at second traffic light (Farmers First Bank) to PA-772 E into Mount Joy. After 772 turns to the right, take the second left on to New Haven St, right at traffic light on to Main St, left at Hamilton Bank on to N. Market St.

Enter the blue double doors marked "Alois's" toward the south end of the building along Market St. and go up the stairs to the Ballroom. We have our own restrooms with limited changing space.

The building is a registered national historic site housing three unique dining areas. Alois's by Ophelia Horm in the hotel dining parlors serves complete dinners from about \$15 to \$24. The Catacombs in the brewery cooling cellars features entrees from \$10 to \$18 and a Medieval Feast most Sunday evenings for \$30 per person. The Bottling Works and adjacent beer garden feature lighter fare in a casual atmosphere with live music most weekends.
