A performance artist, actress and author of Gender Outlaw: On Men, Women, and the Rest of Us, will perform her one womyn play The Opposite Sex is Neither on March 17th. The performance will benefit the American Educational Gender Information Service, Inc. and Atlanta Gender Explorations Support Group, and will coincide with the annual meeting of the International Foundation for Gender Education in Atlanta, March 13-19.

Discussing her is a "pronoun challenge" in that Bornstein, who lived the first 37 years of life as a man, followed by eight years as a woman, now chooses to be identified with neither gender. Bornstein's book, *Gender Outlaw*, challenges even the most progressive notions of gender in our society. This performance promises to be an even further challenge to the stereotypes that limit our understanding of what it is to be a person.
