The MMRF was established in Dec. 1981 in order to offer assistance and support to the female-to-male transsexual, his wife/fiancee/girl friend/lover, family members and friends. Many of you have had occasion to take advantage of a variety of our services, ie.: information, referrals, counselling, research, peer-contact/ support, newsletter, etc., at one time or another. So now, we are asking you to PLEASE show us your appreciation and support of the efforts we have made, and are continuing to make, in your behalf, and on behalf of the F-M TS fraternity, as a whole, by sending in your membership dues (\$25), newsletter subscription fee (\$15) or a contribution (from \$5 to \$25 and more) as soon as you can. (If you wish to have your correspondence/newsletter sent in a plain, unmarked envelope, please advise and we'llbe happy to oblige). Even if you don't need our services at this time and you don't wish to receive the newsletter, we are still very much in need of, and would greatly appreciate, your financial support (even if it's only a few dollars--every little bit helps! All four members of the Board of Directors personally contribute \$25 each year out of their own pockets). And, last, but not least, I am still in the process of putting to-gether my "MANUAL FOR FEMALE-TO-MALE TRANSSEXUALS"--which will include a section on phalloplasty (penis reconstruction). Of course, I am still interested, also, in the possibility of designing a nonsurgical, external, penile prosthesis ("penis-substitute").
