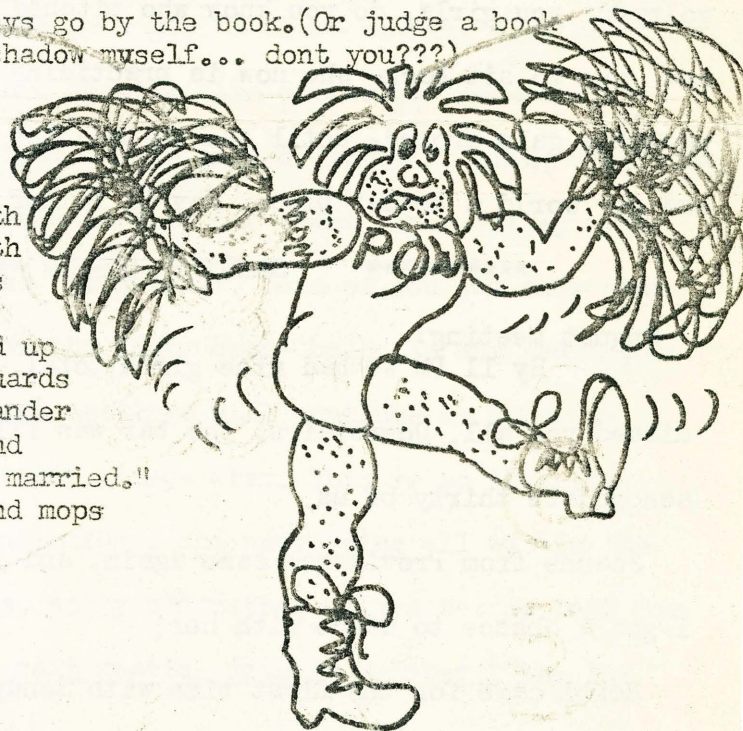


PCWs Held 'Super Bowl' with Gal Cheerleaders
