He performed in clubs in New Jersey and Philadelphia while still in high school.

After learning the art of applying make-up and hair styling, he soon built up enough confidence to build a show around himself which he eventually brought to the Silver Slipper in Las Vegas. That was "This is Boy-Lesque" in 1977.

Kenny has a motto that if you're not proud of what you're doing, don't do it. He is proud of what he is doing and he does it to perfection. His family is very supportive of Kenny in his professional endeavors, and rightly so. "Boy-Lesque is a tribute to his many talents, total professionalism and a great sense of timing and outrageous wit. With his partner, Roger Caldwell, Kerr has produced and directed an innovative "Boy-Lesque" for the past six years.



"LITTLE 'LIL" - was born in Grosse Pointe, Michigan. This entertainer has appeared throughout the United States and Canada and now makes his home in Las Vegas. He is considered to be one of the finest comedians in the business.
