Below is a description of ECFTMG for inclusion in your upcoming book. I have also enclosed a few recent meeting flyers of ours, and a sample newsletter.

The East Coast Female-to-Male Group (ECFTMG) is a peer support network for female-to-male transvestities, transsexuals, and their partners. Founded in 1992 by Bet Power, the group meets monthly in Northampton, Massachusetts and draws individuals from throughout New England. Sunday get-togethers typically include a topic discussion, video showings, and a potluck dinner or outing to a local restaurant. Meetings are held in Mr. Power's home, which also houses The Sexual Minorities Archives. ECFTMG meetings and events and are open exclusively to FTMs and their partners.

I will be attending it with friends of mine who live in Spokane, WA — Mykael (the FTM) and his wife, Jeannette. I have known Jeannette for about 10 years.
