Second, I promised to share a true interface with the gender community in distant lands as a personal tribute to my husband's unique gender gift. I stand on the threshold of both dreams. The organizations in Australia and New Zealand anxiously await our arrival and joyfully anticipate time together as friends from across the seas.

The gold of friendship is a magic thing. The more we spend it on each other, the richer we become.
