The vision of ALP grew out of the expressed need for innovative and unified community strategies to address the multiple issues impacting LGBTST People of Color Communities, ALP secured and moved into its Fort Greene home, in the parish house of the Lafayette Avenue Presbyterian Church, during the summer of 1996.

ALP coordinates and is a founding member of the MSM/ WSW/ MST of Color Outreach Working Group.
