Samuel Cohen, fifty two of 60 White Oak St., who was an agent with the United States Internal Revenue Service, died Sunday of a heart attack at his home. He collapsed around 9 p.m. and could not be revived. He had been under a doctor's care for a heart condition.

Mr. Cohen had been associated with the government agency since 1942 and worked during that time in the White Plains and Port Chester offices. He was in the White Plains office more recently.

A son, Martin, 13, a sister, Miss Minnie Cohen of Boston, survive. His wife, the former Lucy Pines, died two years ago.
