Personal Papers

Jaci Adams memorial collection, 2012-2014, Ms. Coll. 55

Jaci Adams (1957-2014) was a vocal transgender and HIV/AIDS activist in Philadelphia from 2001 to 2014. The Jaci Adams collection spans 2012 to 2014, and is comprised of awards she has given, official governmental proclamations, and memorial objects.

J.D. Davids papers, 1990s-2000s, Unprocessed

J.D. Davids is a trans health activist who lived in Philadelphia through 2002. The collection contains materials produced by Davids and others in the course of his work in Philadelphia for the City's HIV Commission, Philadelphia Fight (including Critical Path, the AIDS Information Network, and Project Teach); material produced in the course of his activism in ACT UP Philadelphia, AIDS GAP, and the 2000 Republican National Convention protests and arrests.

Ben Singer papers, 1989-2007, Ms. Coll. 51

Ben Singer is a public health activist who had an active voice in the Philadelphia transgender community from the 1990s to 2000s and beyond. The Singer papers are comprised of organizational paperwork dealing with the trans-focused public health initiatives he helped found (such as the Trans-health Information Project) and the local politics surrounding community outreach and activism.

Donna Mae Stemmer photographs and ephemera, 1981-2010, Ms. Coll. 42

Donna Mae Stemmer (1933-2015) was a lawyer, Korean War veteran, fashion icon, and trans activist from Pennsauken, New Jersey. The collection includes thousands of 3 1/2 x 5 in. and 4 x 6 in. color photographs of Stemmer dressed in nearly as many outfits, as well as personal documents, LGBT material, ephemera, and two articles of clothing from Stemmer's wardrobe.

Riders Against Gender Exclusion (RAGE) records, 2007-2013, Ms. Coll. 46

RAGE (Riders Against Gender Exclusion) was founded in 2009 by a small group of Philadelphia-area trans and allied activists in order to bring attention to and ultimately change

the Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority (SEPTA) policy of using binary gender stickers on their transportation passes.
