#### PROVENANCE

This collection was a gift of Wilma Weissman in 2007.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection consists of photos and video from Wil (Wilma) Weissman and her partner Benay Phillips mostly taken in Cherry Grove, Fire Island, NY. Much of the material documents the many annual events of Cherry Grove's drag queen community, such as the Miss Fire Island Pageant, The Pines Invasion and performances at local venues like the Ice Palace and Cherry's with local personalities such as Candy Stevens, Teri Warren, Lulu, Bella, Dorian Corey, Paris Dupree, Johnny Savoy, Panzi, Miss Saleen. Gay Pride Parades and The Gay Games in New York City are documented along with The Miss NYC (drag) Pageant at the LGBT Center. It should be noted that the folders are labeled according to the labeling on the albums of the collection, but the contents do not always correspond to the event on the label and/or include multiple events not identified.

## HISTORY OR BIO

Wil (Wilma) Weissman and her partner Benay Phillips owned a co-op at Grove manor in Cherry Grove, Fire Island, NY for 18 years. Beginning in 1986 with Wil doing still photography and Benay taking video they covered all the many events during the summer at Cherry Grove. Wil and Benay were involved in the lives of the Grove's drag performers. They also considered the staff of the Ice Palace, Cherry's and the Grove's other bars and restaurants part of their "family." While most of the photography was for their own enjoyment, Wil and Benay did become the official videographers for many of the events as CCC Productions. They both worked as healthcare professionals and were together for 34 years until Benay's death in 2006 of scleroderma.
