

**FOR FIFTEEN YEARS A MAN.**—In Milwaukee, Wis., on Wednesday, Chief Janssen arrested one Frank Blunt, who was wanted at Fond du Lac on a charge of grand larceny. Then a search developed that Frank Blunt was a woman. For fifteen years she had dressed and acted as a man, drinking, smoking, gambling, and swearing with the rough crowd in which her life was passed, and not once was her identity known. She said her name was Annie Morris. Her family lived at 42 Blower street, Halifax, Nova Scotia. Annie, fourteen years ago, ran away, accompanied by her brother, who was two years younger. She was at that time thirteen years of age. The mother was dead, and the cruelties of the father, the girl says, caused them to leave home.
