Summary

Title: The Oral History Project, c. 1940s to 2000

Size: 9 boxes, 82 audio cassettes; 3 video cassettes; 105 photographs; scrapbook. (Note: July 2015 – only 26 audio cassettes found in box)

Restrictions: Several interviews have restrictions on them and researchers will need either GALA's or the interviewee's permission to use them.

Background note.

GALA's Oral History Project was launched in co-operation with journalist Mark Gevisser to provide background material for Gevisser's film biography of Cecil Williams (*The Man who Drove with Mandela*) - See AM2663 for the interviews relating directly to Cecil Williams.

Scope and content.

A1 consists of more than 52 interviews on audio cassette with lesbians and gay men older than 60 at the time of the interview. Some of the interviews have been transcribed, and include some photographs and memorabilia. Not all interviews are accessible due to privacy embargoes and restrictions. A1. Is the bulk of the collection.

A2 consists of interviews conducted to provide background material for the *Man who Drove with Mandela* documentary. Stored with the Mark Gevisser collection AM2663.
