Tracy: Man faces court

MAN was charged yesterday with the murder of 11-year-old Tracy Watters.

Adam McDermott, 26, appeared briefly on petition before Paisley Sheriff Robert Ingliss.

Schoolgirl Tracy was found dead in a back garden half a mile from her home in Craigview Avenue, Johnstone, Strathclyde, on February 15.

The charge that McDermott faces is that behind a house in Shanks Crescent, Johnstone, McDermott punched Tracy in the face, seized her, removed some of her clothes and murdered her by compressing her throat.

Defence lawyer Ross Harper made no plea for McDermott, of McLaurin Crescent, Johnstone. He was remanded in custody and will appear in court again before the end of the month.

A police spokesman said "Princess Michael was not injured in the attack. A man is helping us with our inquiries.
