I just can't get this Richard Speck thing out of my mind. Richard Speck murdered eight nurses on April 15, 1966 and was sentenced to life imprisonment in 1967. He died of a heart attack at Stateville in 1991. Unbeknownst to prison authorities in 1988, he did a video interview with other prisoners about his life behind prison walls.

A few weeks ago Bill Kurtis, the anchorman for Channel 2 News and a producer of many documentaries for Channel 11 and A&E got ahold of it. Its content was splashed for an entire week on all the Channel 2 newscasts beginning on Monday, May 6th.

The Promos were all about how much cocaine, marijuana, sex, and free reign of the prison he had while behind prison bars. His quoted comment was something like this, "I can't believe I could have so much fun behind prison bars!"

All sorts of thoughts were going through my mind after I heard that. Is he a cute little guy who with a little extra effort could look female. Is he transgendered? Is he gay? Did he become a Jail House Queen to make the best of a bad situation. He obviously must be peddling his female looking bod to buy cocaine and marijuana that he shared with his fellow inmates?

I decided right then and there to watch the next newscast on CBS.

It was sick, sick, sick! I watched it at the 4:30 news and again at 5. On the 4:30 news, he was sitting down with what could be panties and without a shirt on. They had blocked out his chest area somewhat but you could still see what appeared to be rather good sized boobs. On the 5:00 o'clock news, they didn't blockout anything and you could see rather large boobs flopping around. At least a "B" plus. What the difference in a half hour made to block out or not to blockout I can't begin to figure out.

Instead of a Jail House Queen, all I saw one of the ugliest looking men imaginable! And extremely male looking in spite of having what appeared to be boobs. All it did was show the depths a person can sink to after twenty two years in a prison with a mind that was sick enough to kill 8 innocent nurses in the first place. Spare me Bill Kurtis.

Dennis Rodman, of Bull's fame has written a book called "I Wanna Be Bad". In it he talks about his body piercing, his tattoos, his desire to be made love to by a man, and his desire to wear woman's clothing. To show how unspeakably "bad" he really is, he chose to attend his book signing engagements in a strange form of drag, heavy eye make-up, some sort of a female top, and a feather boa.

Earlier this year in Denver, Security at a hotel ran a "road block" at the Ladies Room and checked the ID of all that walked out. Several TSs and CDs were taken into custody and turned over to the local police.

We're suddenly going backwards. All these hotels have their own newsletters and magazines for their industry where they air common problems. You can bet your bippy problems with our culture and the general public are well covered.

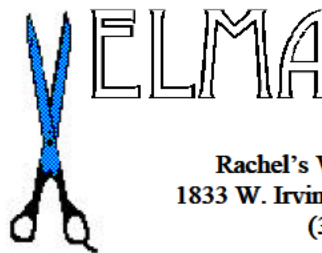

But taking a group of CDs to a straight theater, regardless of what is showing, is sure to attract attention. And if they tried to use the Ladies Room, there would be hell to pay.

Illinois, the City of Chicago and the various municipalities around haven't made a public issue of CDs using the Ladies Room yet.

If groups of CDs go to straight restaurants or theaters, laws prohibiting the use of a Ladies Room by a male regardless of his attire will shortly follow. A woman will look at us and unfortunately, the first thing they will think of is Richard Speck and be scared to death!

Let us all be discrete before our culture is thrown back 50 years!
