Springfield, Ill., Dec. 13. - Gov. Tanner ordered the surrender of Ellis Glenn, in jail at Hillsboro, to West Virginia officers, in which state she is charged with forging notes on J. C. Richardson. Judge Dwight at Hillsboro ordered the indictments charging the prisoner with forgery quashed and she was immediately turned over to the sheriff of Wood county, Va. and becoming engaged to Miss Effa Dukes, forged a note on her affianced's father and skipped out on the evening

before the wedding.
