Description: Elise van der Merwe (Bishop) is a MTF transgendered person, who told her story in the Afrikaans media in 1982 (series A). Elise received many letters from individuals who read her story, and these letters and her written responses comprise series B. Some of these letters were from other transgender people and in one instance was accompanied by photographs (part of the reason for the confidentiality form users must sign). Elise lodged the material in this collection with a publisher with the intention of publishing a never completed memoir. The bulk of the records are in Afrikaans.

Special formats: Photographs;

record (LP); statuette; douche set and cream (stored in archive office)

Language: The records are primarily in Afrikaans.

Press clippings from *Rapport; Sarie; Die Transvaaler; Suidwester Rand Daily Mail; Republikein;* and others: 1982-1983. (All but one clipping in Afrikaans). 1 folder (Note: *Rapport* did a series of 7 articles on Elise over November/December 1982).

B. Correspondence (1980s)

B.1. <u>Correspondence with public</u> (1982-1983, 4 folders) **RESTRICTED**

Letters and cards written to Elise (some via *Rapport*) from various individuals, including other transgender people in November/December 1982. Includes letters/cards written to Elise with the original envelope, as well as her reply (typed on her personal letterhead with Namibia address) in Dec '82/Jan '83. The letters and envelopes contain correspondents' full names and addresses (though from 1982/3). Researchers are therefore required to sign a confidentiality agreement before accessing.

Folder 1: Replies written Nov/Dec 1982 (19 letters and replies – one of the letters contains photos send by the sender)

Folder 2: Replies written 4-6 January 1983 (16 letters and replies)

Folder 3: Replies written 6 (contin) and 7 January 1983 (15 letters and replies)

Folder 4: Letters and cards written to Elise with no reply attached (5 letters, 5 cards, 1 postcard, 1 fax message, 2 empty envelopes

Folder 5: List of names and addresses of all 41 people who wrote to her after the *Rapport* articles, including a breakdown of numbers per province and gender. Note that some of the correspondence above was repeat (i.e. some people wrote to Elise more than once).

B.2. <u>Correspondence with the media</u> (1982, 1 folder)

Four letters from Elise to the editor at *Rapport* discussing the articles about her (also one reply).

"I'm also submitting for inclusion the record of my singing issued by AKA Johannesburg at age 15 when still a boy plus a spare cover. Only record so cannot replace! I'm keeping the CD but my executor has instructions of what must be made available to GALA in the event of my death." (email correspondence between GALA and Bishop, January 2024)

Elise' first attempt to get her autobiography published in the 1980s and early 1990s under the title *Kennis van die Noodlot*. This was sent to GALA by Elise Bishop in July 2022.
