Conditions of Participation

In these Conditions, the term "organization" refers to Fantasia Fair, Ltd., and the term "participant" refers to the person signing the Registration Form.

(1) Registrations will be accepted by all persons who have reached their 18th birthday prior to October 15, 1976.

(2) Fantasia Fair participants are expected to wear femme attire and dress appropriate to the occasion.

(3) The deposit of \$50 per person shall be treated as partial payment of the total sum due, as stated in this brochure and by agreement between the organization and participants.

(4) The cost of full participation in Fantasia Fair is based on a minimum of 50 participants. Should participation fall below this number, all monies will be refunded except for a \$25.00 overhead charge.

(5) Refunds for canceled registrations are as follows:

(a) Cancellation before June 15: \$25.00 (half of \$50 deposit).

(b) Cancellation between June 16 and Sept. 15: 50% of total cost of selected plan.

(c) Cancellation between Sept. 16 and Oct. 8: 25% of total cost of selected plan.

(6) The organization reserves the right to make necessary program changes. Participants will be informed where possible of such changes, and offered these alternatives:

(a) To accept the changes.

(b) To cancel participation and accept a refund of 80% of all monies paid.

(7) Except where otherwise stated, the organization acts only as an agent in securing accommodations and other personal services. The organization shall not be liable in the event of failure of contracting parties to honor their commitments. The organization will not be responsible for injuries or lost personal effects.

HOW TO GET TO PROVINCETOWN

BY CAR— Leaving Boston, take 128 south, or Southeast Expressway to Rte. 3. Continue on Rte. 3 over the Sagamore Bridge to Rte. 6, which takes you all the way to P-Town. From the south, take I-95 to Providence, then 195 to Wareham, Mass., where you can get on Rte. 6 to P-Town.

BY PLANE — On arrival at Logan Airport (Boston), contact PBA Airline for flight times and reservations. For flight reservations in Boston, call [REDACTED] or (toll free) Delta Airlines at 1-800-962-3500.

BY BUS — Trailways and Greyhound buslines have frequent daily service from Boston to Hyannis, with a change at Hyannis to P-Town. Call bus line for schedule.
