WHAT IS IFGE?

The 'International Foundation For Gender Education' is a non-profit tax-exempt organization serving the Crossdressing/Transsexual Community, those persons affected by that Community, and those persons serving that Community.

WHAT IS THE COMING TOGETHER CONVENTION?
