DEATH REVEALS "WOMAN" CUE CHAMPION WAS MAN

SAPULPA, Okla., March 30 (AP),---Death has revealed that Frances Anderson, known for many years as "champion woman billiard player," in reality was a man.

Anderson ended his own life here yesterday by slashing his throat and wrists with a razor. Not until the body was prepared for burial did the secret of 30 years of masquerading become known.

Crumpled in one of the woman's stockings he wore, was a letter indicating he had contemplated death and carrying a plea that his secret might be kept.

"Do what you want with my body," the letter said, "but don't let the world know my secret."
