and was instantly killed.

Monster meetings were held throughout Australia in honor of St. Patrick's day, and large sums raised for the furtherance of the Irish cause.

James D. Hayes, who was involved in the Post Claim Bureau swindle in Chicago, has died of shame on account of the exposure of Post's methods.

The banking and commerce committee of the Dominion parliament to-day passed the bill incorporating the supreme court of the Independent order of Foresters in Canada.

A unknown man in attempting to board a train in the Boston and Maine depot at Boston yesterday afternoon fell under the wheels and was killed. He was evidently a laborer.

Hi-Yang, the Chinese cook on the American ship Southern Cross, attempted to kill the captain on the voyage to Sydney, and in self defense the captain shot and killed him.

Peter Nearshalaky, the miner who was imprisoned for 54 hours at Black Diamond collery and who was liberated on Saturday, died to-day from nervous exhaustion and internal injuries.

Trouble between the operators and miners in Ohio seems inevitable since the failure of joint convention to agree upon a scale of prices at the meeting in Columbus, and trouble is likely to start before the lapse of many days.
