Transexuals Plan Wedding

Alternative press writer Angela Douglas, 33, founder of the Transexual Action Organization (TAO) and co-founder of the Eon Society, and Tisha Goudie, 30, former TAO Defense Director and the final president of the Transexual Rights group, have announced their engagement.
