

Nothing But A Heartache.....The Flirtations (the

hile Francis Cardinal Spellman lived, it was generally assumed among the gay population of New York City that this high priest of St. Patrick's Cathedral was gay. There never seemed to be hard proof of this. But that never stopped the rampant speculation about Cardinal Spellman's sex life.

Spellman has been dead now for over twenty years and there is still speculation surrounding the mystery of whether the Cardinalthe man of the cloth who counted politicians, popes, and presidents as friends and enemies—was homosexual. In his prime, Cardinal Spellman was considered to be one of the most powerful men in New York City, in fact one of the most powerful men in the country and in the world.

..... Cooney is quoted as saying, "Spellman formed a liaison with a chorus boy who appeared in the aptly named Broadway play One Touch of Venus. After evening performances, the archdiocesan limousine arrived at the theater's side entrance. The chorus boy entered and was driven to Spellman. Word of the affair spread beyond clerical circles because of the youth himself. A layman who stumbled onto the affair was C.A. Tripp, who later became a sex researcher affiliated with Dr. Alfred C. Kinsey of the Institute for Sex Research in Bloomington, Indiana... A friend...introduced Tripp to the young man whom Spellman was seeing. The youth was so outspoken about his relationship with the churchman that Tripp was flabbergasted. He wondered why Spellman wasn't more discreet.

Von Hoffman himself tells us that "Cardinal Spellman was probably homosexual...Spellman's sex life was a source of profound embarrassment...There were stories about his seducing altar boys and choir boys. He had his favorites among handsome young priests and was known to have lovers outside the clergy..."

The young seminary student became friends with "...lean, intense Francesco Borgongini-Duca," a twenty-seven-year-old teacher. "The reserved Italian responded to Spellman's persistent attentions. They were seen to-gether constantly." The relationship seemed to have been fostered by Spellman, and mainly because of his undisguised ambitions.

When he was twenty-seven, Francis Spellman became Father Spellman, a priest in the Roman Catholic Church. His first assignment was in Boston under the supervision of William Cardinal O'Connell. The two did not hit it off and in fact disliked each other intensely.

The New York Times ran a story in 1985 about why references about Cardinal Spellman's supposed homosexuality were deleted from their Book Division. Sidney Zion, as he tells us in The Autobiography of Rou Cohn (Lyle Stuart, 1988), asked Cohn, "What do you think about them saying Cardinal Spellman was a fag?"

"Hey," Cohn answered. "They say it about me." Ironic. Cohn, up to the end, also denied having AIDS. Roy Cohn was homosexual

and he died of AIDS.

Aside from the gossip that Cohn shared with Spellman, the Cardinal also "loved the gossip that F.B.I. types relayed about the sexual practices of congressmen and other people of prominence.

For years rumors abounded about <u>Cardinal</u>
Spellman's being a <u>homosexual</u>. As a result, many felt that Spellman the public moralist may have been a contradiction of the man of the flesh. Numerous priests interviewed took his homosexuality for granted."

Spellman was fast climbing the Catholic ladder of power. After one year in his job, he was elevated to the rank of monsignor. "There was always a circus side to the Vatican and Spellman was the star attraction." Pope Pius XI referred to the newly appointed monsignor as "Monsignor Precious."

Spellman's star rose. He was now an intimate of Massachusetts politicians. "He was in with Joe Kennedy, and he could pick up the phone and ask for the President (Franklin D. Roosevelt) and get through." But Spellman's big break was just about

Spellman became the new Archbishop of New York.

Within his new office behind St. Patrick's Cathedral, Spellman "brooked no mavericks" among his subordinates.

One....Three Dog Night

Von Hoffman in his biography of Roy Cohn says that, "For years people speculated on whether or not the Cardinal and Roy might have had some kind of sexual relationship."

During an outing on Cohn's boat, Hoffman says, "Spellman would come aboard with a gay layman friend....

Columnist Murray Kempton said about the Cardinal: "Everybody was a little afraid of him."

Washington political analyst I.F. Stone called the Cardinal, "a son of a bitch."

Supreme Court Justice William O. Douglas said, "I came to know several Americans who I felt had greatly dishonored our American ideal. One was Cardinal Spellman."

As far as Cardinal Spellman's sexuality goes, author Gore Vidal, an uncloseted homosexual who was miles apart from the Cardinal politically, stated it quite plainly: "The serious crimes of Spellman

were not sexual."


