As you requested, I attended the Gay Male Sexual Dysfunction Group at Pacific Presbyterian Hospital yesterday. Two urologists spoke to the group of about 25. Alec (the moderator) talked to me at length on the phone a few weeks ago, asking a lot of questions which I answered truthfully without disclosing my background. There will be no meeting next month, but there will be in June.

I also wrote to Biber and Kenney about the "genitoplasty" - Biber answered that he does not perform that type of surgery ("the penis is too small"), and I haven't heard from Kenney as of this date. However, through Kim Stuart and Lin Fraser, I learned that Dr. Michael Brownstein is now performing genitoplasty! Went to see him and he is willing to operate on me. This week I hope to see one guy who he did - Lin said he is very pleased with the results.

As I am very interested in having this operation done close to home, and Dr. Brownstein has done some surgery on my chest (with which I am pleased), I ask that you send the letter of recommendation to him for me.
