The Board has voted to repeal the recent By Law amendment(s) that prevent two members of a self-defined family or couple from serving on the Board, or as Monarch, at the same time. In order for this to be changed, the Board's decision to repeal them must be ratified by a simple majority of members.

The specific By Laws in question are the following:

Article IV, Section A, Number 11: No two (2) persons of a self-identified family or couple may serve on the Board of Directors at the same time, including the position of Monarch.

And

Article V, Section B, Number 2: No two members of a self-identified family or couple may serve as reigning Monarchs at the same time.
