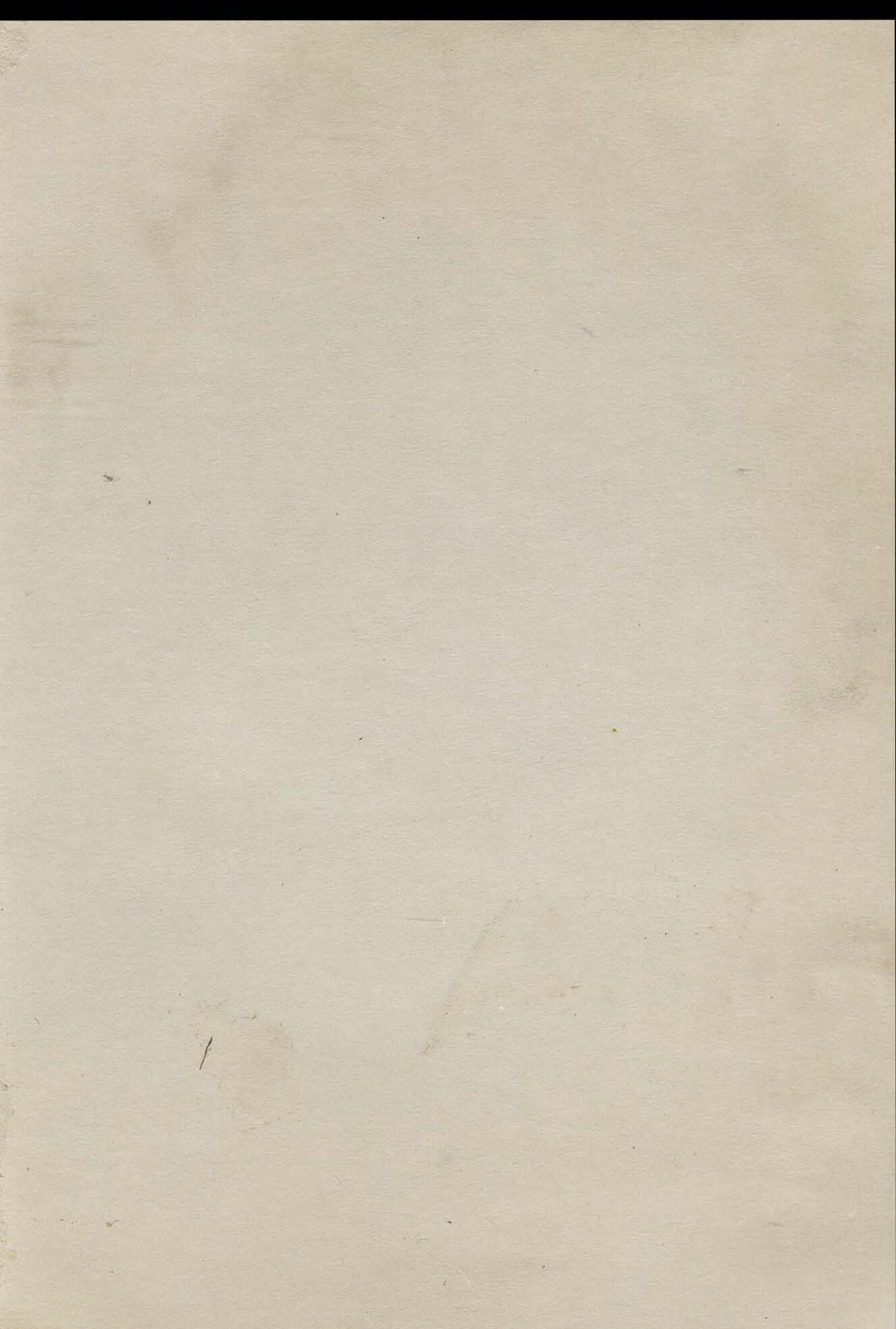

Dear Penny,

Got up at 9:00 'cas I had to sing 10:00 Mass (funeral) I went straight to Lamo's House. We started taking Lamo's Christmas decorations down. I got evergreen needles all over the livingroom. We packed everything in boxes tied them up with string, and put plastic bags over them. We took them downstairs + cleaned out the storage area + Lamo found her old Christmas cards and I cut the up with the ~~3~~ scissors for namecards. I went home and watched "Saturday Night at the Movies" and went to bed at 10:10. Mom is still sick. But we got the paper back.
