"If a man is given female sex hormones it will give him a semblance of female breasts; fat distribution in the body will be altered to give a more female appearance, and the sex drive will be reduced. "Others will ask for more radical operations — complete castration, even the creation of artificial female sexual organs, "Others will ask for cosmetic
