Dear Sir:

Attached to this letter you will find zeroes of over twenty pages of petitions signed by around 350 people, mostly from this neighborhood, asking you take action on the new findings in the Marsha P. Johnson MURDER case.

When the table is not outside, all day long people come in and ASK to sign this petition, a blow-up of which is displayed on our store window. Many of these people are people who knew Marsha & are upset that nothing is being done to follow up on the recent leads which I believe you have seen on videotape.

We have also printed 1500 leaflets calling for action & urging those concerned to let their voices be known to you. These are just being circulated now in bookstores, the community center, other shops in the area, etc.

I would hope that you would recognize the widespread sentiment in this neighborhood to have this MURDER solved. Why do we have to petition, leaflet, print "JUSTICE FOR MARSHA" buttons & march on the Sixth Precinct to get what is obviously simple, common-sense law enforcement?


I'm sure if it becomes necessary to sit-in, picket, or engage in other protests at the Sixth Precinct, we will certainly do it. I find that nearly everyone is incredulous that nothing is being done about these new developments--especially those who have seen the 15 minute interview with Bennie Toney in it's entirety.

You are newly in charge on this case & I hope that you would see action is taken and that these mugger/murderers are brought to justice.

Last July, the Sixth Precinct spent almost no time investigating but WASTED 30 or more police man-hours dealing with a demonstration by those outraged over its inaction. That is NOT in anyone's interest.

If something concrete hasn't occurred within the next couple days, we will have to take action. I hope you will contact me in the very near future.
