An engineer from Rugby, sacked when his employers learned he had decided to change sex and come to work dressed as a woman, has been reinstated — thanks to the overwhelming support of 2,000 colleagues. Today a union chief said the company, GEC Telecommunications Coventry, had been taught "a sharp lesson that such in discrimination will not be tolerated."

However, an industrial tribunal in April ruled Miss Hollingworth had been unfairly dismissed, because she had a medical problem for which she was blameless.

Mass meetings of more than 2,000 supervisory, technical and clerical staff voted overwhelm-ingly in favour of reinstatement.

Today it was learned that GEC have decided to give Miss Hollingworth, 31, another job.

She is expected to start next week, and will receive salary increases which would have been due during her dismissal.

Unfair

"Clearly, both the tribunal and working colleagues have given GEC a sharp lesson that such discrimination will not be tolerated."

GEC A spokesman said: "The decision to terminate the services of Miss Hollingworth was taken after proper consideration of all the facts.

'However, the Industrial Tribunal came to the conclusion that the company's decision was unfair.

"The findings of an independent statutory body must be given the fullest attention, and in the light of the tribunal's the company decision, have offered to reinstate Miss Hollingworth in another location on the Stoke (Coventry) site."
