## WAS QUEER CASE

Jury Is Discharged and Ellis Glean Case Brought to Close.

Parkersburg, W. Va., July 30.—The Ellis Glonn case was brought to a close this afternoon by Judge Simpleton, who dismissed the jury on their own request and upon their statement that they could not reach a worklet. Their last hallot resulted in seven for conviction and five for acoustical.

The case was one o file most sensational in the criminal history of West Virginia and cost me state thousands of dollars. The entire case hinged upon the identificatio nof Ellis Glenn as being the same as one Bert Glenn, formerly of Williamson, W. Va.

Over one hundred witnesses were examined pro and con and the best criminal lawyers in the state were arrayed against each other. While Ellis Glenn appeared in court attired as a woman, the proscention sought to identify her as Bert Glenn, a male.

The decision of the jury seemed to have had but little impression upon the prisover, she merely smiling when the result was announced. Her recognizance was extended by the court until next Thursday.
