ABOUT THE WEEKEND: The purpose of the Weekend is to have fun. To do that the participant has a wealth of options, ranging from enjoying good company at the Crown & Anchor's piano bar, to roaming Cape Cod's spectacular beaches, to exploring Provincetown's many delightful shops and fine restaurants, or visiting a friendly beauty parlor or two. Needless to say, there will also be lots of parties. Again, the weekend is dedicated to friendship, and to simply having a good time.

(If you are concerned about what to expect, do not worry. The Weekend coordinators and veterans are there to help you and guide you. After all, we have all been through it ourselves.)

WHO IS WELCOME: All persons who enjoy crossdressing, their spouses and friends.

CODE OF CONDUCT: The Tiffany Club is a non-profit non-sexual social club emphasizing friendship and support. It is expected that all participants at any Tiffany function will dress tastefully (whether that be in masculine or feminine attire), will exercise good manners and common sense at all times, and will protect the security and peace of mind of all.

ACCOMMODATIONS: The Crown & Anchor, and The Chicago House.

The Crown & Anchor is where participants register, and is the center of activities. It is a self-contained motor inn with a piano bar, disco, restaurant, rec room, pool, and gym. A timid (or lazy) participant need never venture from the safety of the hotel, and can still have a wonderful time.

The Chicago House is a lovely and comfortable guest house just two blocks from the Crown & Anchor.

FEES: The rates include a room with a private bath from Friday afternoon till checkout time on Monday, taxes, gratuities, continental breakfast, and the use of all Crown & Anchor facilities.

Single Occupancy (room with double bed) \$135.00, Couples (room with double bed) \$150.00. Double Occupancy \$95.00, Suite (2 rooms with double bed and pull out couch) \$225.00

This year we can also accommodate those who are unable to stay the entire weekend, or would like to arrive earlier than Friday June 4, or stay later than Monday June 7. (Since this is a service, these 'per diem', or daily rates are not subject to any discount. Also while the Weekend is in progress, unless there is space available the accommodations would not be at Chicago House or the Crown.) The 'Per Diem' rates are: Single Occupancy \$45.00, Couples \$55.00, Double Occupancy \$35.00, Suite \$80.00

DISCOUNTS: 1.) 10% discount for members in good standing of the Tiffany Club, Tri Ess, GGA, Albany TVIC, Mayflower, Harriet Lane's, Crossroads, Paradise, Shangri La, CHIC or TAMS.

2.) 10% discount for Early Payment. Payment must be made in full by March 22, 1982. (This is in addition to the 10% Club discount.)

REGISTRATION: Registration is handled for you by us. All you do is: 1.) Pay the total sum due, less the appropriate discounts. 2.) Tell us when you plan to arrive, and plan to leave. 3.)
