Who's Gay?

A new survey says that 21 percent of American men and 18 percent of women reported they either had been attracted to or had sex with members of their own sex since age 15. However, the study, conducted by researchers at the Harvard School of Public Health and the Center for Health Policy Studies in Washington, also found that only 6.2 percent of males and 3.6 percent of females said they had had sexual contact with someone of the same sex within the previous five years.

The headline in Newsday (August 18), "Study: 20 percent of Adults Have Gay Impulses," was accurate enough, but USA Today (August 17) caught more of the ambiguities with its banner, "Study Fuels Homosexuality Debate: Results Point to Gray Areas in Definitions." The New York Times for some reason ignored the study until September 6, when it weighed in with a short AP story, "Homosexual Attraction Is Found in 1 of 5".

It's now clear that the widely reported figure released last year by the Battelle Human Affairs Research Centers (and ballyhooed by right-wing groups), claiming only 2.3 percent of men had ever had a homosexual experience, is ludicrous.

According to Randy Sell, a co-author of the new study, the number of gays and lesbians "all depends on what your definition of homosexuality is. Using different measures, you come up with different results."

The findings also lend support to Kinsey's bell curve, finding that the great majority of people fall somewhere in between absolute homosexuality and absolute heterosexuality. There's more sexual fluidity out there than is commonly recognized.

That's not to say sexual orientation is a choice—it certainly isn't for those of us at either end of the spectrum. And even those toward the center don't "choose" whom they're attracted to or fall in love.




