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Erwin K. Koranyi - "Sex Change Surgery in a Male Transsexual"

"..... Many of the diagnostic subgroups of gender dysphorias are vaguely defined. Therefore, the most important and often confused criteria in separating a variety of sexual behaviours should be dealt with briefly.

A male homosexual is a male with sexual interest in another male, achieving various degrees of orgiastic genital satisfaction. He may take the active, the passive, or alternatively, both roles in the relationship, usually with a preference for one or the other. Some have marked, in fact exclusive, interest in the feminine role. In spite of this they are not usually willing to give up the genital organ, theri source of orgiastic pleasure, as it would involve sacrificing the means of their sexual satisfaction. Sometimes deceived by their intense fantasy and desire to be a female, they indulge in self-administered or prescribed estrogen therapy, but as soon as they become impotent as a result of this practice, they stop. Some of them like to go around in "drag" and find delight in being "queens", but they are nevertheless deeply involved in the world of homosexuals, without any wish to give that up - a more or less inevitable consequence of a sex-change operation. Only some, feminized to an extreme, may ask for a sex change operation. In the face of otherwise good ego strength, if the desire is sufficiently intense and the narcissistic pleasure surpasses the loss of orgastic satisfaction, they may be considered reasonable candidates for the operation. Thus, a certain kind of homosexuality no longer constitutes an absolute contraindication, but such candidates demand extra caution and prolonged study before a decision is reached concerning the surgery. A few in this group, however, may

The transvestite is a part-time cross-dresser, essentially a fetishist, whose 'turnon' is the act of dressing itself. Secretly, or sometimes in trusted company, not infrequently with so-specialized prostitutes, rarely with their consenting wives, they cross-dress in order to bring about erection and sexual excitement. Fractised in clandestine fashion and often in fear of discovery most of the time, their outlet is autoeroatic and is accompanied by intense feminine fantasies to which they are addicted. They usually are heterosexual, and a homosexual adaption is seen occasionally. Contrary to a real female, they prefer unlikely and provocative dresses or underwear. Their actual appearance is frequently of secondary importance, even grotesque, as they do not really wish to convince anyone of their femininity, except themselves, in their sexual fantasies. Having achieved genital orgasm, they usually go back to their customary male world and activity until the next sexual urge appears. Since they are usually neither identified permanently as a female nor do they wish to give up orgastic pleasure, they too, represent poor choices for surgery in general. A good example of transvestism was exemplified by a patient of mine in the following way: exceedingly shy, he never dared to go near girls. He nevertheless experienced an over-powering desire to "slip his hand up under the skirt of a girl". Once, when 16 years old and alone at home, he spotted his sister's skirt lying out on her bed. He held it up in front of himself and "as a dream come true" he saw a skirt and a pair of legs in the mirror. He immediately put on the skirt and finally performed the much desired act of "petting", followed by autoerotic outlet. "I became my own girl friend." Not denying the presence of deeper psychodynamic content preparatory to such an event, this was nevertheless the technical aspect or imprinting of becoming a transvestite in his case. Since that time, the habit grew into an increasingly bold desire to continue the practice until he became a renowned female impersonator. He never had a desire for sex change surgery. Only occasionally does a true wish emerge in a transvestite to become a female and to engross more and more in the obsession of continual cross-dressing.

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WASHINGTON (UPI) -The Supreme Court Monday rejected claims by an elementary school teacher that she had a right to keep her job after surgery which changed her from a man to a woman.

The appeal by Paula Grossman, formerly Paul Gross-man, was the high court's first encounter with an issue involving a transsexual. She argued that the 1964 Civil Rights Act ban on sex discrimination applies to her.

Miss Grossman, who is in her 50s and fathered three daughters before the operation, lost her case in state and federal courts.

The Equal Employment Opportunity Commission also turned down her arguments, and Monday's Supreme Court action apparently ends the case.

Another transsexual, Renee Richards, made the headlines during the summer with her

claim that she was entitled to participate in women's tennis. She also argued that transsexuals should be afforded the same rights as those born female

Hired as a man in 1959 by Bernards Township, N.J., to teach elementary school music, Miss Grossman was fired after her 1971 operation on grounds her presence in the classroom might cause psychological harm to her students.



WHAT SIGN ARE YA? HI. Critic Kenneth Tynan ex-plained he "just didn't feel like wearing an ordinary suit" and appeared at a London party wearing a dress.

She argued in court that the only reason for her dismissal was her sex and it was irrelevant how she became a woman. Federal District Judge George H. Barlow said in dismissing her civil rights claim that "the court finds it unnecessary, and, indeed, has no desire, to engage in the resolution of a dispute as to the plaintiff's present sex."

Even assuming Miss Grossman is a true female, Barlow

said, she was not discharged because she is a woman but because she surgically changed her sex.

In another sex discrimination case, the justices agreed to decide whether cities can separate high maintain schools for academically ex-ceptional boys and girls. The court will decide before next July whether Susan L. Vorchheimer, an honor student, was illegally denied admission to all-boy Central High School in Philadelphia.

Lower courts held that Miss

Vorchheimer had no right under the Equal Educational Opportunities Act to attend Central and that some education experts and parents thought single-sex schools were of value to adolescents.

2 Men Dressed As Women Rob Bank With 'Soap Bomb'

Baton Rouge, La. (UPI) -- Two as women yesterday dressed men robbed a bank with a fake bomb made of soap and survived a wreck between a stolen taxi and a carnival ride operating in a shopping center to escape.

Police said the men took a cab to the Bon Marche branch of Capital Bank and told the driver to wait while they made a deposit.

Once inside, the men threatened a teller with what they said was a bomb and escaped with an undetermined amount of cash. They jumped in the cab and were about to leave when a bank official yelled to the driver that his passengers were bandits.

Police said the driver jumped out and the gunmen tried to escape in the car. They got several hundred yards before crashing into a carnival ride in the shopping center parking lot.

Officers said the pair fled on foot and commandeered another car at a nearby apartment complex to complete

their getaway. The "bomb" turned out to be soap and an alarm clock.

A LITTLE boy walks along the street, secure in the company of the man he calls Daddy.

He's been told his mother was killed in a car accident. Little does he realize that his bearded father was, in fact, his original mother.

This man is one of 1,300 transsexuals who have been treated at the clinic of noted psychiatrist Dr. John Randell. This week the doctor and his patient spoke with The Star — on condition the patient's name would not be disclosed.

The patient, Mr. X, wanted to 6 hope my son tell his help others trapped in the tragic mid-world of doubting their sexual identity.

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Mr. X was born a female in the English Midlands in 1938 and never knew his father, an Army man.

"I knew a succession of 'uncles' who were always visiting my mother," he told The Star.

At nine, he was put into the first of several orphan homes where he stayed until he was 21.

"From an early age I wanted to play with boys," he said. "Girls and their dolls never interested me." me.

He was pleased when he didn't develop large breasts at puberty and could cover his small bosom beneath a big shirt.

He took a factory job where he dressed mannishly in trousers and cut his hair short. Finally he moved to London.

"One night I went to a party and met a man. Five months later I realized I was to be an unmar-ried mother.

"I was thrilled. I had always wanted someone to love. Now I felt this baby could fill the void."

He was glad the baby was a boy — "if I couldn't be a man I could bring up one instead" — but found that playing the part of mother worsened his mental agony.

Mr. X sought help at London's Charing Cross Hospital, where he received hormone treatments and eventually underwent several operations.

But, though he was able to grow a moustache, his fellow factory workers wouldn't accept him as a man and made remarks about him. He quit the job and found another.

His child, however, did accept his new identity as Daddy rather than Mommy, a term the boy re-served for his babysitter, anyway. "And when he was four, I told
