Abraham "Chico" Sanchez (aka Chablis LaBlanc) left us in his sleep early Friday morning, September 9. He was a member of the RSICSS, AVES and the Littlemore Family of Austin—a hair "burner" of great renown all over Houston. He first became known to the gay community as a dancer. He is now best remembered as a female impersonator and philanthropist. He was Houston's only perfect Judy Garland, but hardly limited himself to her music. In 1992, he was Miss Cousins, a title of which he was extremely proud. He loved, helped and touched many lives in his short 35 years. Among the many benefits he organized were five annual Cinco de Mayo shows for AVES. He did more than his share of work and happily provided his full share of colorful controversy. He was charming, usually upbeat and slightly loopy. He always had a smile, even at the end.

He is survived by his loving mother, several brothers and sisters, many nieces and nephews, and many, many gay brothers, sisters and friends in every Imperial Court city in Texas (at least).
