PAYMENT INFORMATION

August 31: no discount.

September 30: add 5% surcharge on Part A fees.

October 10: add 15% surcharge on Part A fees.

Cancellation Information

Should you decide to cancel your participation in FanFair '92, we require notification in writing. Refunds are made according to the following schedule:

- By February 15: full refund (less \$75 processing fee).
- By April 1: loss of deposit (considered a donation to the Outreach Institute).
- By June 1: loss of ½ Part A fees paid on account.
- June 2 to September 1: loss of all deposits on Part A fees.
- After September 1: All payments become a donation to the Outreach Institute.

NOTE: We do all negotiations and pay deposits to the Provincetown establishments by June 29. Hence we must know you are coming by June 2. Consideration will be given in the event of a bona fide medical withdrawal with appropriate documentation.
