Stonewall, the Movie: The Stonewall riot of 1969 will be re-created complete with crowds, cops and drag queens beginning tonight in New York City as part of the filming of "Stonewall," a BBC movie about the incident at the Greenwich Village bar that was linked to the beginning of the gay rights movement. Production began two weeks ago on the film that tells the story of six gay men in New York in the days leading up to the riots. In addition to exploring the men's relationships, the film will recount the bloody rioting that occurred between gay men and police at the Stonewall Inn during the weekend Judy Garland was buried. But because the owner of the Stonewall would not allow film crews to shoot in front of the original bar in the Village's Sheridan Square, the pivotal riot scenes will be filmed nearby in a re-created square.

Dear Williamson.

First, let me apologize profusely for being so out of touch. Soon after I spoke with you, we moved quickly into production, and for the past seven weeks I have been quite ill. I seem finally to be on the mend; but I am leaving the project in two days, returning full-time to Boston and parenting my three-year old--and will hopefully make a full and speedy recovery.

As I mentioned in our conversations, Program One is about lesbian and gay activism that was produced primarily in the aftermath of Stonewall. The Producer who took over Program One made the decision to interview those Stonewall witnesses who continued with political work--such as Gay Liberation Front and Gay Activists Alliance. The audio interviews that you and others provided have been very helpful in our understanding the tenor of the times, the events surrounding the raid and the range of moods and sentiments about those early days of resistance. Regretfully, I wish that we could have more film time to explore the experiences of people such as yourself who made the riots such a landmark in gay history.

In terms of the ad In <u>The Imperial Queens</u>, I was given permission during a personnel turnover. Our current budget contains no applicable line item. However, I don't want to leave with your feeling deceived by me. I know you took time out of a very busy schedule, and opened your home and memories to me. If the situation means that we would part on less than friendly terms, I would rather write a personal check to <u>The Imperial Queens</u>. Let me know what you think. On a personal note, it was very rewarding and inspiring to meet you in the course of this project, and to feel the pride, the humor, anger, intelligence and courage that came through as your described your life.


