

TRACEY'S POISON BREW, BY A QC

● **SEX-CHANGE** seaman Tracey Stamp cooked up a witch's brew to poison her lover, a court heard yesterday.

● Stamp, a friend of nude round-the-world sailor Rosie Swale, boiled up laburnum seeds, muttering: "Hubble, bubbly, toll and trouble," Winchester Crown Court was told.

● Keith Vincent, Stamp's boyfriend, was violently ill after

his food was laced with the brew, said prosecutor Roger Titheridge, QC.

● After Stamp moved out to live with Rosie, Mr Vincent's stomach pains stopped, the court heard.

Stamp, 45, of Penffordd, Dyfed, South Wales, denies trying to injure Mr Vincent, 36.
